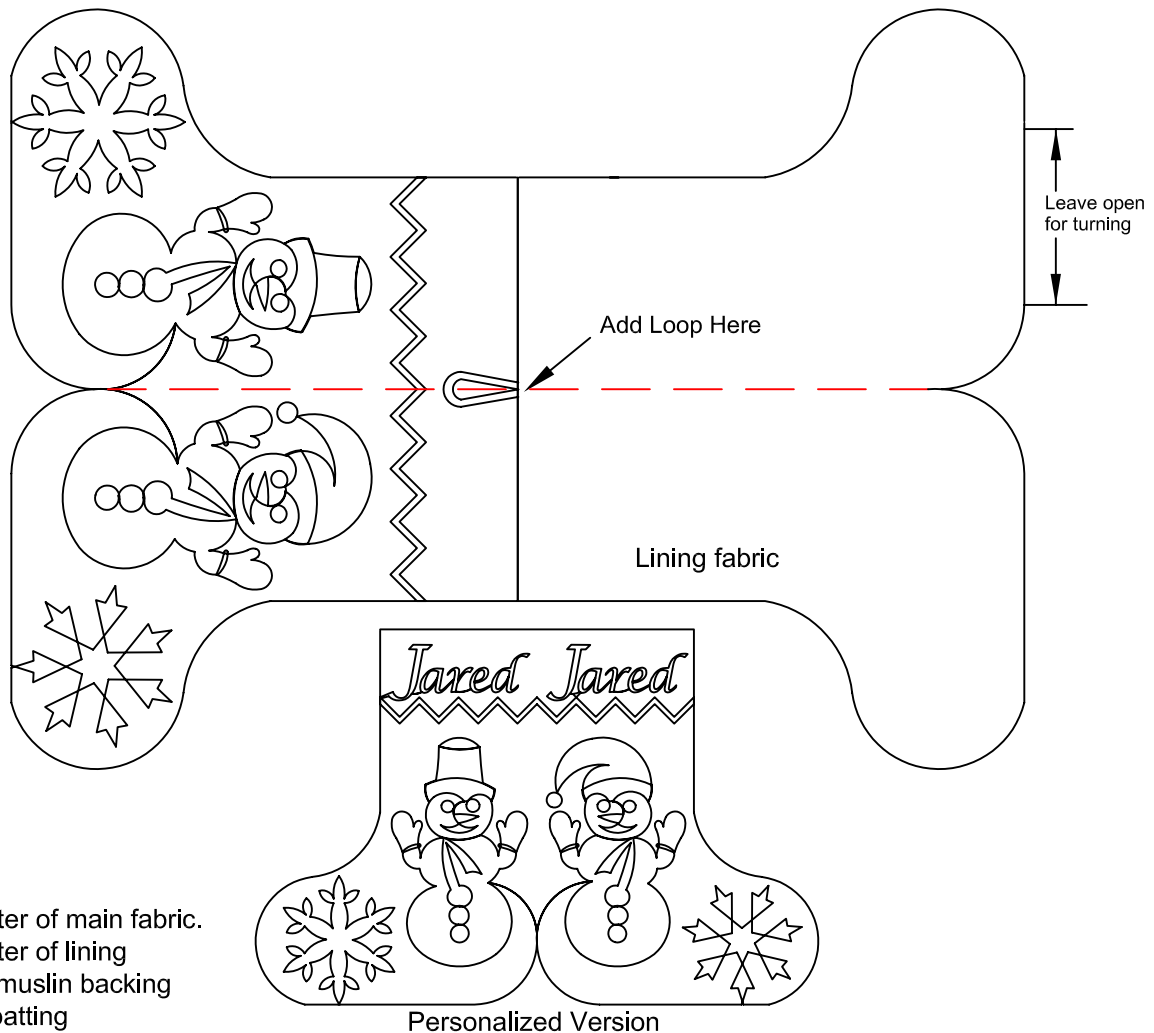


Instructions for completing Designs By Deb Christmas Stocking



Supplies:

- 1 fat quarter of main fabric.
- 1 fat quarter of lining
- 1 yard of muslin backing
- scrap of batting

1. Read all instructions before beginning. Load backing and batting onto machine as you would for a quilt. Adjust the size to fit your needs. Baste your fabric to the batting/backing on top and both sides. Open pattern and choose repeat blocks. Stitch out design.

2. Remove from machine and trim pieces $\frac{1}{4}$ " beyond the outer most stitching line. You will be using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam line throughout which should put you just inside the stitching outline. You do not want the stitching line to show on the outside so use it as your guideline and stitch just inside of it.

3. Cut a 2 x 7" wide strip from the leftover fabric for hanging loop. Fold in half and then fold raw edges to center. Topstitch.

4. Cut a lining piece the same size as the stocking. Baste hanging loop in place as shown. Place lining and stocking right sides together and sew across the top only. Lay out flat as shown. Fold lining and stocking on foldline right sides together. Pin in place and stitch all the way around just inside the stitching line leaving opening at bottom of lining for turning. Slip stitch opening closed and push lining inside stocking topstitch around top of stocking and lining through all layers.

6. For personalization of stockings, please contact me. Cost is \$10 per name (maximum 6 letters). You will receive a separate file with each name with the stocking all in one file. You can also add embellishments and personalize it yourself with glue and glitter, beads, applique, sequins or embroidery.
